I noted slight rendering odors next to the rendering bins, some of which were not fully closed/sealed. Ms. Pressley said they were being picked up today. I request that they be completely closed going forward. The odors appeared to only be present in that immediate area. We then walked to the fields where the mineral/wash water/blood is spread and filled deeply into the ground. I noted no odors in the field area.
